## **INTRODUCTION**

**India is an agriculture based country and we can see that our base is in worst condition due to faulty farming methods, disaster, climate and irrigation water condition.**

**There is a need of some modern and commercial agriculture, which is equipped with modern techniques, less water consumption , high rate of return.**

**Keeping in mind all the above condition we the team of The Glad Bharat Foundation identified Mushroom Cultivation the best for the development of rural people and their lives.**

**Mushroom as an agriculture product will not only give price satisfaction to the people engaged in this activity, but also will help to improve their living and the society as a whole.**

## **GOAL**

**To stop 70% labour migration in coming 3 years from the date of project implementation.**

### **How To Achieve**

**To achieve the goal a hard and dedicated teamwork is needed.**

**In first phase of project implementation, a group of 200 people is formed, most of them is women.**

**After making them skilled in mushroom cultivation through skill training, Glad Bharat Foundation team will provide them sponge (seed of mushroom) at their panchayat.**

**From the very first day all the people will be engaged in cultivation activity under the GBF Team's supervision.**

**Each people will work on a very small unit of 10x10 sq.ft. sized mushroom hut.**

**In first phase 200 hut will be introduced for this.**

**Production in kg of 1 hut is 110kg approx. if correct technique is used.**

**At initial phase we will have a production capacity of 22000 kg of mushroom, engaging a group of 200 people.**

**After cutting of mushroom, Glad Bharat Foundation will give them a market for their mushroom, in their panchayat by equipping the panchayat by Glad Bharat Foundation Collection Unit.**

**This collection unit will act as a strength for the farmers by eliminating the struggle and burden they face in selling their other agriculture produce.**

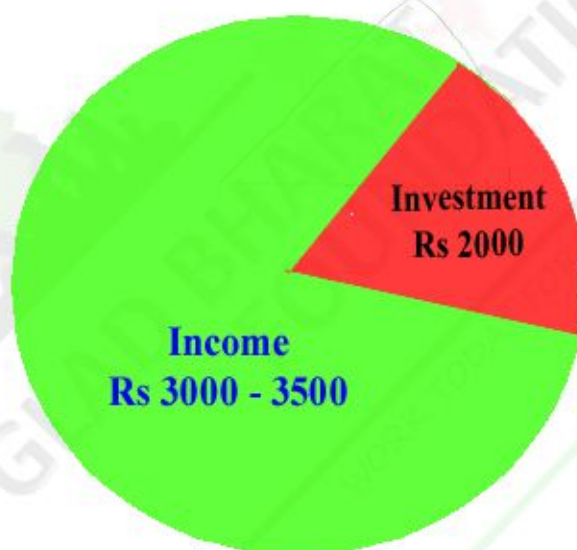
### **Result Of This**



**In this activity those people are engaged who are dependent on labour works in bricks factory and construction sites in big cities. When we talk of labour migration these people contributes the most.**

**Due to the engagement in mushroom cultivation activity, initially some unskilled labour migration will decrease in the panchayat where this project**

**will be implemented.  
In this an average income of 3000 to 3500 per person  
per hut will be generated.**

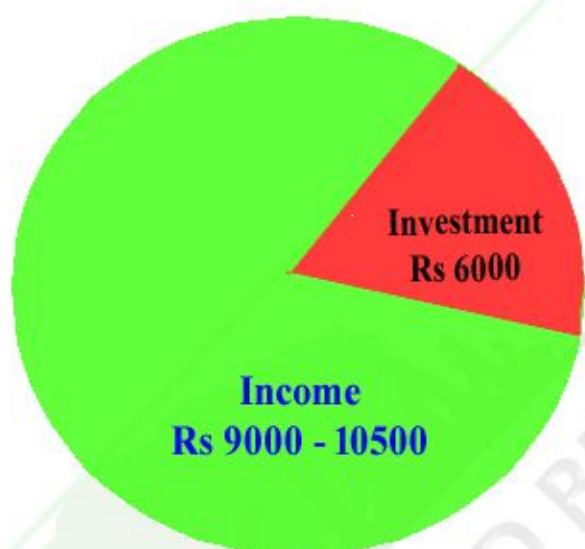
### **Pie Chart Of Expected Income & Investment Per Person Per Hut**

**Time Period of one cycle of production is 45 days.  
After having skill training in mushroom cultivation  
one can earn Rs 3000/- to Rs 3500/- by investing  
Rs 2000/- in a hut of size 10x10 sq.ft.**

**After 2 cycle of production, GBF Team will encourage each people of this group to increase 2 hut of same size. This will increase their income from Rs(3000-3500)/- to Rs(9000-10500)/- per person.**



**Expected after 2 cycle (90 days)**

- Income in rupees per person for 3 hut
- Investment in rupees per person for 3 hut



**Expected after 4 cycle (180 days)**

- Income in rupees per person for 5 hut
- Investment in rupees per person for 5 hut

**After achieving this in six months, GBF Team will work to engage more unskilled labours in this activity.**

**In coming three years we will have a panchayat where we will achieve the target of stopping 70% labour migration and giving them a good source of livelihood by engaging them in mushroom cultivation through skill training for livelihood program under initiative “MAI BHI SAMARTH HU”**
