Glad Bharat Foundation is a Non-Government Organization working basically to make the society Self-Reliant.

An organization through which we want to give back lost dreams and hope for a better tomorrow to everyone. Life hasn't been easy for anyone at any point in time. However, it has been even worse for a few with a lack of available resources. We started as a few hands in August 2019, eagerly looking forward to creating leadership at every level of society, by engaging the society to work for becoming a self-reliant society by improving present condition of education, environment, health and livelihood. Glad Bharat Foundation works primarily with children and women. The organization is working every waking hour towards authentic development and contributes largely to sustainable development.

"Currently, five initiatives are being implemented on grassroot to achieve the goal of making a society self-reliant. In all five initiatives covering four indices have a common goal of developing local leadership, so that they may address their own local issues and can work for its solution. This is what we call a self-reliant society.

We use initiatives as a tool for developing local leadership, by regularly engaging them in activities of education, environment, health and livelihood.

HOW WE DO

Our flagship initiative is PAD-ATM. PAD-ATM is not only limited to health of women but it is a solution for affordability and accessibility of sanitary pads to women.

We connect PAD-ATM to need based locations at rural areas, urban slums and under-resourced schools. When we connect with the people for PAD-ATM, in the process of operation, we focus on developing leadership in the community, so that thay may address their issues. The community raises their local issue related to education, environment and livelihood and since we work to make society self-reliant, our aim is to mobilize the community to take actions. We provide resources for the solution of the issue raised by them and the community takes the responsibility of operation. We provide every resources in the form of knowledge, designs, material, process of operation and implementation with proper followups.

We work with community for one to two years and then we move to a different location. Now the community leaders them self takes proper steps for the solution and implementation. They take ownership of the development process at their locality and we support them if needed by making resources available to them in the form of material like pads, books, stationaries, sewing machines etc.

We generate resources from DWDB Campaign. DWDB stands for Donate Waste Discover Best campaign and it connects urban privileged popullation in the development of rural popullation from less privileged background.

Whole process is a community led activity where community takes ownership

- 2. Group discussion Wemen are divided into groups to disscuss on health, hygiene, nutrition and material used during period.
- 3. Need identification: After discussion, wemen are engaged iin need identification and possible solution to solve the issue

Women Reached

PAD-ATM are the normal thermocol boxes, which might become a landfill if not utilised as PAD-ATM. It is an innovative step of Glad Bharat Foundation, in which we are not manufacturing any pads, but are outsourcing it from Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Pariyojna and other local vendors. Each PAD-ATM contains 50 packet of saniatry pads, each having four pieces in it. Community uses it by paying Rs4/for one packet and Re1/- as community contribution for refilling it.

PAD-ATM are fully operation at 15 location by the community itself. Community are becoming self-reliant on the issues of menstrual health & hygiene by operating PAD-ATM.

PAD-ATM is acting as a catalyst in removing taboos, shame and educating women and men on the behaviour change. With PAD-ATM, a healthy dialogue exchange are happening between genders for having the pads for them when the PAD-ATM box get refilled on regular basis.

At school, due to PAD-ATM girls are not missing their attendence during their period days. PAD-ATM is working on the psychology to make each one self-reliant on the issues of menstrual health, hygiene and responsibility.

Skill Training For Livelihood

The root cause of every problem of the society is undoubtly, the unavailability of correct source of livelihood.

When we started our journey for conducting CHARCHA, to know the ground problem related to menstrual hygiene, we wittnessed that for maximum women who are not using safe pads during period was the financial crisis.

We heared Kiran Devi, at Tekari block, Raniganj Village, where she mentioned thatwe have 3 daughters who have attended puberty and the cost of one pad is 30 to 40 rupees. We have two time meal in that amount, which cost for buying for all three of us.

It is clear that CHARCHA & PAD-ATM is not only limited to menstrual health & hygiene, but are making society to take actions on root cause also.

We have three skill training centre at Gaya and Nawada district on Bihar, where 45 women on each quarter completes their skill training and start to take action on developing livelihood from local market.

Community contributes a small contribution to the local leader who gives skill training to them. The purpose behind the contribution from the community is to develop a sense of dignity and value from both end.

GREEN CAMPUS

GREEN CAMPUS is an initiative of Glad Bharat Foundation, which mobilises the community to take actions on the activity of environment protection. Children and community people are provided with the plants sapplings, and they plant it, protect it to grow into trees.

GREEN CAMPUS, is making the society self-reliant on the issues of environmental protection activities.

In this picture, we can see a concrete, non green campus gets converted into GREEN CAMPUS, by the children of this school.

We have converted 12 campuses into GREEN CAMPUS at GAYA.








GLAD BHARAT PAATHSHAALA

Glad Bharat Paathshaala, is a local learning centre, which connects every child to school. Last year 300+ children wrer connected with school through our 6 Glad Bharat Paathshaala.

Local leader teaches at these paathshaala for 2 hours per day, five days a week, to raise the interest of the children with school and education. After one year we ask the mothers of these children to get them enrolled at nearby schools.





SKILL AT SCHOOL

Currently we work at 2 under resourced schools. Youth leaders who are good in computer knowledge takes the ownership to teach at school with a 1 year commitment.

At 2 schools, 2 youth leaders are giving computer skills to more that 240 children of standard 6 to 12.





DWDB CAMPAIGN

DWDB means DONATE WASTE DISCOVER BEST

DWDB Campaign is the the major source of resources to run all initiatives of GLAD BHARAT FOUNDATION.

It develops partnerships between privileged people of urban and less privileged people of rural, Urban people become a part of the development of rural people from less privileged background, by contributing waste papers, used paper and most important news paper. News paper is used at skill centre by women for learning cutting of clothes for tailoring. Some women use it for making thonga for their livelihood. 25 out of 100 are used in these andrest 75 are exchanged at recycling unit in monetary form. These money are used for transportantion and buying resources for initiatives.










Breakdown of Growth Achieved


