Founded in 2019, Glad Bharat Foundation began with a vision to create grassroots change where it's needed most. What started as a small initiative in rural Gaya, Bihar quickly grew into a movement focused on foundational learning, menstrual dignity, health and community empowerment.

At Glad Bharat Foundation, we believe transformation begins when communities are heard, trusted, and empowered to lead their own progress.

Harshita's Story

ENDING SILENCE

Read how *Harshita* overcame stigma and gained confidence to speak openly about *period* for the first time.

Harshita Kumari, 28, is a mother of two daughters and a son, living in Mahodar village, Bodhgaya block, Gaya district. Despite her deep desire for her daughters to receive education and grow up confident, Harshita faced a barrier that many women in her community silently endured: the stigma and taboos surrounding menstruation. For years, discussions about menstrual health were considered shameful, leaving her and other women isolated, unsure, and often unprepared during their cycles.

This silence took a toll on Harshita's confidence. She had questions, fears, and experiences she wanted to share, but the lack of a safe, supportive environment kept her voiceless. "I always wanted to talk about what we go through, but there was no one to listen, and we felt embarrassed even among our neighbors," she recalls.

The arrival of Glad Bharat Foundation's Pad-ATM initiative and Charcha sessions brought a turning point. The team approached the women with patience, respect, and empathy, carefully creating a safe, inclusive space. They listened before speaking, encouraged open dialogue, and addressed each concern with sensitivity. For the first time, Harshita felt comfortable sharing her experiences openly — the struggles, the fears, and the impact on her daily life. "It was the first time I could speak about these issues without fear. I felt heard, valued, and supported," she said.

The Pad-ATM ensured access to sanitary pads, transforming a practical need into a tool of empowerment. Coupled with the Charcha sessions, Harshita gained knowledge, confidence, and a sense of dignity. She now speaks freely about menstrual health and guides her daughters with awareness and care.

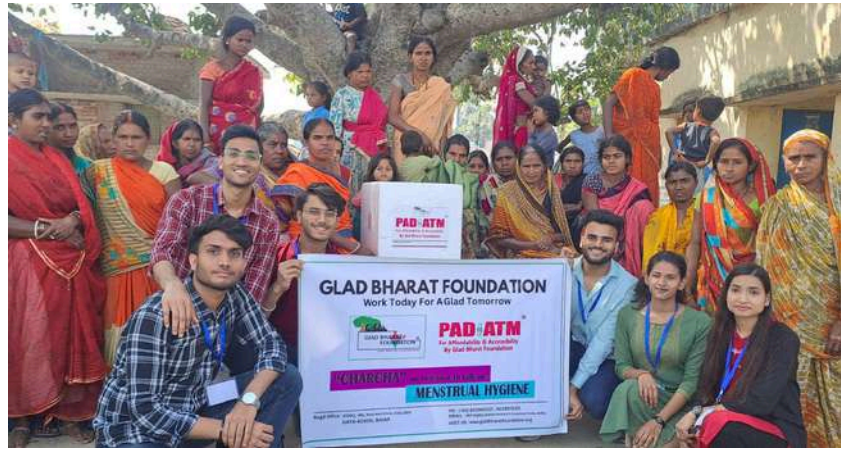
Harshita's journey illustrates how thoughtful, compassionate engagement — a team that builds trust and creates safe spaces — can break lifelong silences, transform stigma into confidence, and empower women to lead the change in their families and communities.

- Two-year partnership (2023–2025) for menstrual health awareness in Assam and Haryana.
- 5,000 women & girls targeted over two years.
- In 2023–24, reached 1,300+ women & girls through structured sessions.

Grassroots Activities Of Education & Menstrual Dignity & Health In 60 Days

SIDBI PROJECT

60+ women connected with livelihoods through microfinance linkages and equipped with google listing and QR codes to receive payments directly.

In collaboration with Let's Endrose, Glad Bharat Foundation partnered with the SIDBI Mission Swavalamban Project in Gaya to promote women's economic empowerment and self-reliance. The project focused on creating sustainable livelihood opportunities for women from underserved communities by building their capacities and linking them with financial resources.

Through this initiative, we successfully connected 60+ women with livelihood support, enabling them to access microfinance and take the first steps toward self-employment and financial independence. By fostering linkages with microfinance institutions, the project helped women invest in small enterprises, strengthen household income, and uplift their families.

This collaboration reflects our commitment to holistic development—where education, health, and livelihood come together to create pathways of dignity, resilience, and long-term change for women in rural Bihar.

As part of our commitment to women's economic empowerment, Glad Bharat Foundation organized stitching and paper bag making training programs for women and girls in underserved communities. These skill-building workshops aimed to equip participants with practical abilities that could translate into sustainable livelihoods.

Through hands-on training:

- 30+ women and girls were trained in paper bag making, creating eco-friendly products for income generation.
- 20+ women and girls were trained in stitching, gaining skills to produce marketable garments and accessories.

Beyond technical skills, the program fostered confidence, creativity, and entrepreneurial thinking, helping participants take charge of their economic independence. This initiative reflects our holistic approach—empowering women not just with financial tools, but with the skills and confidence needed to build a self-reliant future.

READ HOW SAFE SPACE SUPPORTED AFREEN'S WILL TO CONTINUE LEARNING

In the remote settlement of Katari Hill, learning was once a daily struggle under the open sky. Children gathered with hope and determination, but scorching heat, sudden rains, and chilly winds often interrupted their lessons. Among them was six-year-old Afreen, whose mother Saniya never allowed circumstances to shake her daughter's dream of education.

Saniya recalls, "My daughter sat through the sun and rain because she wanted to learn. Many times, I felt helpless, but I knew her spirit was stronger than the weather."

This year, a ray of hope reached Katari Hill when Shweta Singh, moved by her late father's values, chose to commemorate his death anniversary by gifting a shed for the Paathshaala. What was once a bare space under the sky transformed into a safe, welcoming learning centre.

Today, Afreen attends her classes without fear of being drenched or exhausted by the heat. She reads and writes with joy, surrounded by peers in a place that protects their right to learn. Saniya says with relief, "Now I feel peace in my heart. My daughter studies with comfort, and she enjoys learning more than ever before."

The Katari Hill Paathshaala is more than a shelter — it is a symbol of resilience, love, and community solidarity. It shows that when hearts come together, education finds a way to bloom even in the hardest of places.
